We love to invite new hearts to see the work God is doing and to meet and work alongside the incredible leaders God is raising up here at The Dwelling. Here are a few ways you can join your hearts and hands with us!

FEASTING MINISTRY

Provide a Sunday Meal

Each Sunday when we gather, we eat!

We start with a light breakfast at 10:00 and then a hearty lunch following worship around 11:45. We believe that eating together is holy and so we do it regularly. We plan for and make enough food for 120 people for breakfast and 200 for lunch.

Providing a meal on a Sunday (breakfast, lunch, or both!) can look like preparing and bringing the meal ready to serve, working with our Minister of Meals to create a menu and shopping list and cook the meal onsite, or financially sponsoring (\$600 covers breakfast and lunch) the meals and we'll handle the logistics.

Provide Summer Block Party

In the Summer we party!

We believe that the kingdom of God is ushered in when the whole neighborhood can come together, with all of their differences, to dance and eat together! For that reason we host weekly Block Parties (Wednesday nights in June & July), complete with music, dancing, and feasting to celebrate the kingdom among us.

Providing a meal for a Block Party can look like brining the meat to grill and sides ready to eat, working with our Meal of Minister to create a menu and shopping list and cook the meal onsite, or financially sponsoring (\$700 covers it all) the meal and we'll handle the logistics.

Serve Sunday Meal or Summer Block Party

Many hands make yummy work!

Not sure if you're up for making the meal or sponsoring it? No problem! We'd love to have you or your group help us make sure good food is making it into the bodies of incredible humans. In most cases, helping to serve the meal also includes helping to set-up and clean up.

SHOWER MINISTRY

Pack Shower Kits

Packaged and ready to go!

Each community member who accesses the shower is provided with a complete shower kit that includes all the necessary supplies for a good and restorative shower. We have a complete Shower Kit List available.

This is a great activity for Youth Groups, Scout Groups, School Service Projects, etc. Packing shower kits can look like a group or individual gathering the supplies listed on the Shower Kits List and packing the kits either at home or onsite at The Dwelling. If you're unable to provide the kits supplies, we also welcome individuals and groups to come pack kits with supplies donated through other channels.

Help at a shower day

Rub A Dub Dub!

The shower trailer runs 3 days a week and provides showers to upwards of 60 beautiful humans each week. Helping on a shower day looks like assisting the Minister of Showers to distribute shower kits and clean clothing to each guest. Volunteers will also help set up the supplies, waiting area tent and chairs, and will help to wipe down showers between each use to ensure guests have a clean shower experience. This is 3 hour volunteer commitment.

Shower laundry

Clean humans means dirty laundry!

Want to do something easy at home? Help us keep up with our towels and washcloths after each shower day. Volunteers would coordinate pick-up and drop-off of dirty/clean laundry with the Minister of Showers.

Building maintenance and upkeep
